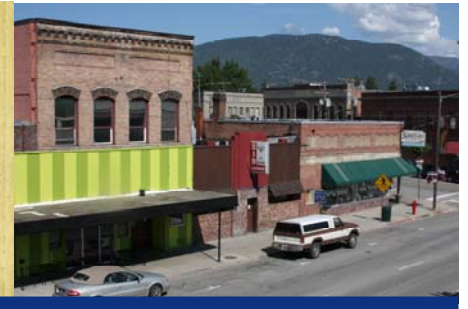

An entertaining fundraiser featuring the documentary Pappy Boyington Field takes places at 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. in the Panida's Little Theater. This events helps raise funds for the Pappy Boyington Memorial Fund, a 501©(3) non-profit established with the initial goal of creating an 8-foot bronze statue of Boyington for the Coeur d'Alene airport. The film tells the story of the grassroots effort to honor this WWII hero in the town of his birth, with a commemorative airfield naming in Coeur d'Alene. However, the campaign was not without controversy. Boyington was the leader of the Black Sheep Squadron in the Pacific during WWII, an ACE fighter pilot, POW, and Medal of Honor recipient.
